Join Rutgers County Agent Mike Haberland for a presentation about cyanobacteria (blue-green algae) in New Jersey lakes and streams. He'll discuss what it is; what it looks like; why is it in the water; and toxic effects to animals and humans.

Mike Haberland is an associate professor and County Environmental Agent for Burlington and Camden Counties with Rutgers University Cooperative Extension. He has a background in aquatic ecology and joined Rutgers in 2009 after nine years with the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection. Mike works with programs to conduct environmental research appropriate to the needs of the community, and implement on-the-ground environmental restoration projects. Mike teaches undergraduate courses in Apiculture, and Introduction to River and Stream Ecology. His current research projects focus on aquatic plant management, cyanobacteria monitoring and treatment, pollinator habitat creation, implementing initiatives for watershed management and conservation in order to implement best management practices, and breeding hygienic honeybee queens.
